The Club meets on Tuesdays and Fridays from 1.30pm – 4.00pm at the Farnham Leisure Centre. The facilities are provided by the Leisure Centre but the sessions are organised by the Club. Ask at reception to be introduced to one of the committee members who will show you the facilities and the clubroom.

Everyone over the age of 50 is welcome at any session as a visitor in order to appraise the Club and the facilities, but they would be expected to join the Club after 3 visits. A payment of £3.00 covers the £1 enrolment and the first annual subscription (£2/year). For each visit an entry fee is also paid to the Leisure Centre, see website for current price.

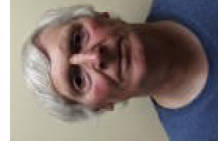
